Executive Board Updates

- Instrument Maintenance Fees: Solon Music Parents is currently paying for maintenance on school owned instruments. Beginning Fall 2019, students using school owned instruments will be charged an instrument maintenance fee on a quarterly basis.
 Directors are working to determine those fees.
- Uniform fees: Band currently pays a uniform fee in the Band Camp fees. SMP is working with the directors to determine Orchestra and Choir fees for uniform cleaning.

Old Business

 Spring Trip update: The Solon School Board voted and the proposed trip to Nashville (March 19-22, 2020) was approved. SMP will aid in fundraising for the trip, which is estimated to cost \$774 per student.

- SMP Membership Proposal

- "I would like to propose adding a family membership fee for Solon Music Parents. Other booster/support organizations such as Solon Athletic Boosters, Solon Academic Boosters, and Solon High School PTA have an annual membership fee. In order to be eligible for scholarships for each of these organizations you must be a current member.

The number of students that Solon Music Parents supports has grown over the past several years. The individual program numbers have grown and choir has been added under the Solon Music Parents umbrella. Membership dues would aid the organization in continuing to support the music programs at the level in which we have become accustomed.

Current dues for booster/support organizations associated with Solon High School:

Solon High School PTA -\$8

Solon Academic Boosters- \$10 (Early Bird-before January), \$25 Family, \$50 Silver, \$75 Gold

Solon Athletic Boosters- \$25 Bronze, \$45 Silver, \$90 Gold, \$225 Diamond I would propose dues for a Family Membership to be set at \$20. Membership includes recognition in a Solon Music Parent publication (newsletter or Pasta Dinner program).

In order to be eligible for SMP scholarships, a student's family must have a Family Membership."

- Motion was seconded by Mark Mauldin.
- Hand vote was taken. Motion passed. One negative vote noted.
